2. **Declaration and Confirmation of Financial Resources Form** _____
3. **Official bank statement, signed and stamped, showing proof of financial resources – of \$26,000 – from either student or sponsor** _____
4. **Official academic records** _____
 - a. All academic records must be originals or certified copies in a sealed envelope from the institution. Copies must be certified (both signed with the seal/stamp affixed) by a school official. Notarized copies will not be accepted. In addition, an official English translation must be provided.
 - b. In order to have credit transferred
 - i. A course-by-course evaluation must be done by an accredited evaluation service. We recommend World Education Services.
 - ii. Plus, course descriptions in English must be submitted for each course intended to transfer.
5. **English proficiency proven by ONE of the following options:**
 - a. Official TOEFL score report _____ (61 IBT, 500 Paper, 173 CBT)
 - b. Official IELTS score report _____ (5.5 or above)
 - c. ACT/SAT score report card _____
 - i. ACT must be 19+ in both English Language and Reading
 - ii. SAT must be 470+ in both Writing and Critical Reading
 - d. Completion of ELS level 12 _____
 - e. Transfer students from a U.S. institution can show proof by completing English I and II with a grade of C or above _____
6. **A photocopy of the personal data page of your passport** _____
 - a. Photocopy of Visa (if available)
 - b. Photocopy of I-20 (if available)
 - c. Photocopy of DS2019 (if available)
7. **Proof of MMR Vaccination** _____
 - a. You must show proof of receiving the MMR (measles, mumps and rubella) vaccination.
 - b. If your clinic needs a form from UAFS to complete the procedure, please use UAFS Immunization Form.
8. **Housing Application (only required if planning to live on campus)** _____
 - a. If this form is not submitted by the application deadline, you will be responsible for finding your own housing arrangements.
