1. Arrival / Departure

- Arrival Date: July 2(Sat) ~ July 4(Mon), 2016
- Departure Date: July 29(Fri) ~ July 31(Sun), 2016

2. Pick-up Service

- Pick-up service is provided free of charge.
- Pick-up service is available at the following places; Pusan International Airport, Ulsan Airport, Ulsan Express Bus Terminal, Ulsan KTX train Station
- Those who fly into Incheon International Airport have to come to Ulsan on their own.
- Participants need to notify exact arrival time and place to the program manager as the itinerary is fixed.

3. Housing
