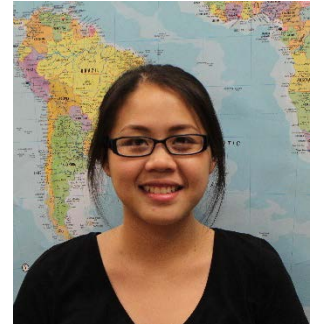
Ntxuzone Yang (Toto Yang)

 - The International Office has benefitted me by providing me with information about traveling and working overseas.



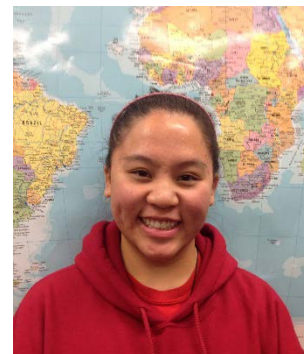
Serena Her
