

## UAFS International Student Immigration Information Contract

As an International Student at UAFS, I agree that I fully understand the rules and procedures listed below.

### **Passport:**

1. May only be extended/replaced by your embassy or at your home country.
2. Must **always be valid** while in the US.
3. Expiration date must be **at least 6 months** in the future.

### **Visa:**

4. May only be issued outside of the US.
5. May expire while in the US, but Passport and I-20 must be valid at all times.
6. If it expires before I leave the US, I must renew it before returning.

### **Maintaining a status:**

7. I must make normal progress in school and complete my studies before the expiration of I-20/DS2019
8. I must always carry my passport and I-20/DS2019 when I travel outside of Fort Smith.
9. I must have been a full time student (**minimum 12-credit hours** at UAFS).
10. I must register with DSO (address, email, etc.) upon my arrival.
11. I must inform International Office about my change of the address **within 10 days**.

### **I-20/DS2019:**

12. Must be issued by Office of International Relations.
13. I must request a new I-20/DS2019 if I change majors or transfer to another school.
14. Must be signed by Designated School Official **every year** for travel outside of the country.

### **Other regulations and rules:**

15. I may **NEVER** work off campus without authorization, and may only work 20 hours a week on campus.
16. **60-Day** grace period after completion of studies to depart from the USA. (Or transfer to another institution or commerce employment of Optional Practical Training).
17. I must apply for OPT 3 months **prior to** graduation.
18. The information on my passport and I-20 must be exactly the same.
19. The duration of my stay can only be shortened or extended by the Academic Department or OIR.
